Studio Information and Rules

- Food and/or chewing gum is not allowed in the studio unless the teacher has made an exception for food or beverages.
- Please make sure to remove your street shoes before entering the studio.
- Students are to be dressed and prepared for class before it starts.
- Children's hair must be neat and pulled away from the face. Please no jewelry. For children's classes, please consult your teacher for the dress code.
- Students are expected to arrive at the studio in sufficient time to prepare for class. When late, students must ask the teacher for permission to enter class. It is the teacher's decision whether or not a student may participate in class for the day. Student may be required to observe class.
- Parents and friends are NOT allowed to observe class except at the teacher's permission.

Inclement weather

- St Mark's dance studio follows the closures of DC public schools during inclement weather.
